Her homes

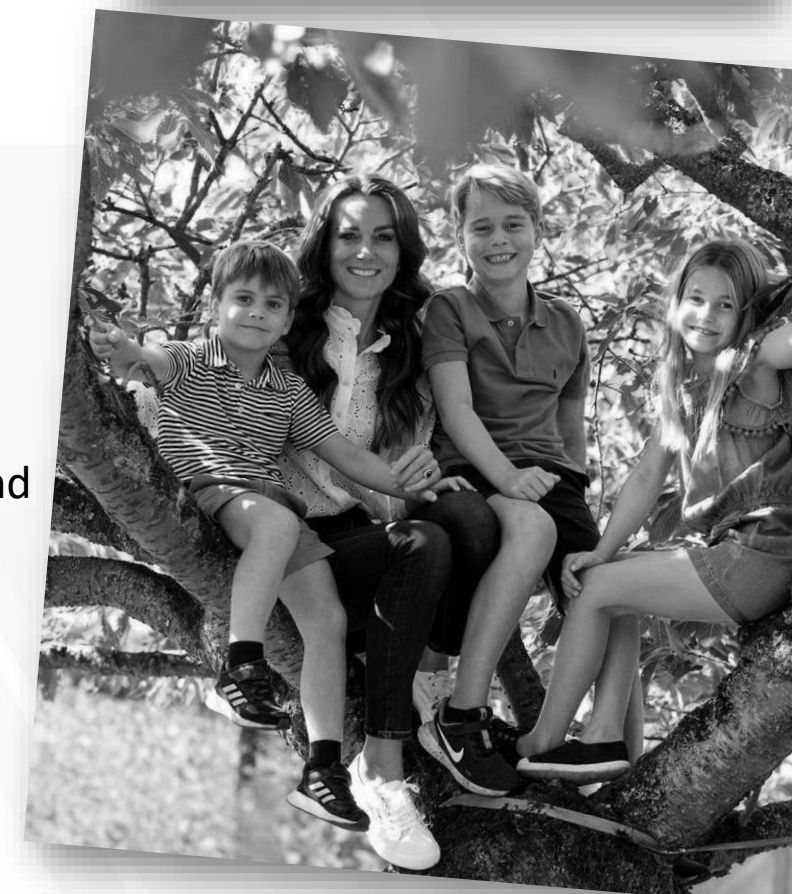
Kate and Prince William have two homes – one is a house in Norfolk, about 100 miles north of London, and the other is an apartment in London.
